Travertine

Product Information



Description

Travertine is a sedimentary stone that is a type of limestone. It was formed by ground waters in caves and springs; the result of this is reflected in the gentle movement and holes in the stone. The stone is characterized by pitted holes, troughs, small crystals inclusions and veins. These are common characteristics for travertine and do not affect the durability. The pitted holes and troughs can be left open or filled with an un-sanded grout if desired.

Flagging: Is 1 1/4" thick and is available in a "French Pattern" 8"x8", 8"x16", 16"x16", 16"x16", 16"x24" . Flagging is full-size to be laid with a butt joint and can be grouted with un-sanded grout over concrete or dry laid over a sand setting bed.

Coping/Tread: Is 2" thick and available in 4"x 12", 12" x 24', 16" x 24" (Bullnose 1 long edge)
